- Originality (contains new findings) and Importance for the region
- Quality (Implementation and the documentation are based on solid evidence)
- Clarity of the presentation
- Good practices criteria:
  - Effectiveness
  - Efficiency
  - Relevance
  - Possibility of replication or scale-up
  - Sustainability
  - Respects ethical and human rights norms
  - Participation of key partners (communities, political engagement, etc.)
