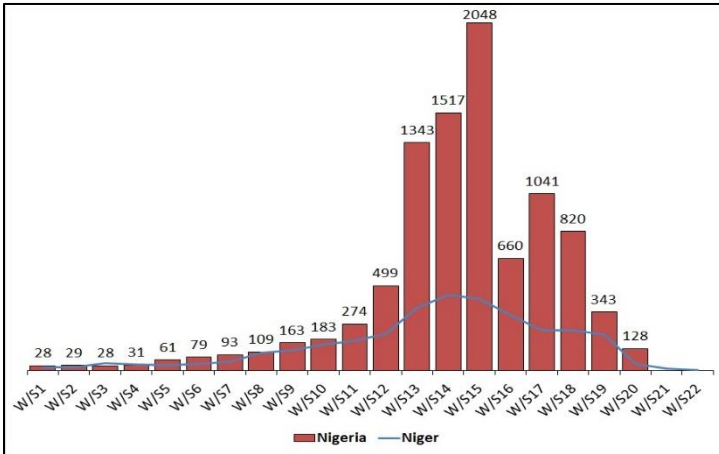


Fig. 1: Evolution hebdomadaire de cas de la méningite au Burkina Faso et au Niger / Weekly progress of cases of meningitis in Burkina Faso and in Niger

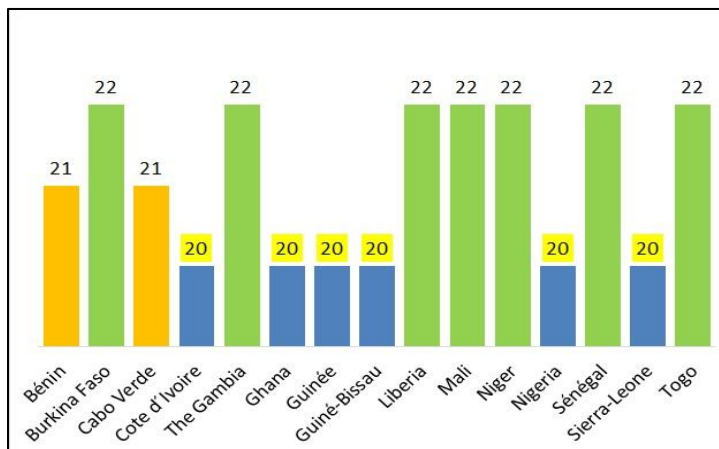


Fig. 2: Complétude des rapports hebdomadaires par pays: Nombre de rapports hebdomadaires reçus par pays / Completeness of weekly reports per country: Number of reports received per country

General comments:

Meningitis outbreak in Nigeria:

- The Cerebrospinal Meningitis (CSM) outbreak entered its 23rd week in Nigeria.
- The number of affected states increased to 25 and four (4) additional LGAs reported a suspected case, bringing the total number of affected LGAs to 230.
- Since onset, a total of 14,298 suspected cases have been identified, out of which 901 samples were collected for laboratory testing.
- 437 of samples tested were confirmed positive for *Neisseria meningitidis*.
- The number of deaths recorded so far is 1,148 giving a case fatality rate (CFR) of 8%.
- The events during the course of this outbreak have revealed gaps in the country's response systems, which need to be addressed for future outbreak response activities.
