ABOUT ECOWAS LASSA FEVER CONFERENCE

With the theme “Beyond Borders: Strengthening Regional Cooperation to Combat Lassa Fever and Emerging Infectious Diseases,” this second edition builds on the momentum of the inaugural conference held in Abuja, Nigeria, in 2019. As Lassa fever continues to pose a persistent health threat in West Africa, LIC 2025 seeks to advance sustainable preparedness, improve regional coordination, and foster research and innovation to strengthen outbreak response and health security across the region.

Over four days, LIC 2025 will convene policymakers, researchers, vaccine developers, healthcare professionals, public health officials, and civil society organisations to share the latest scientific advancements, discuss strategies for effective outbreak management, and explore policy solutions for tackling Lassa fever and other infectious diseases.

The programme will feature plenary discussions, panel sessions, technical workshops, and research presentations, offering a dynamic platform for knowledge-sharing, networking, and action-oriented dialogue. The conference will also work towards developing a regional roadmap that prioritises research, enhances outbreak response capacity, and improves access to vaccines and diagnostics.

Through multi-sectoral collaboration and collective action, LIC 2025 aims to shape the future of Lassa fever control while contributing to broader global health security.

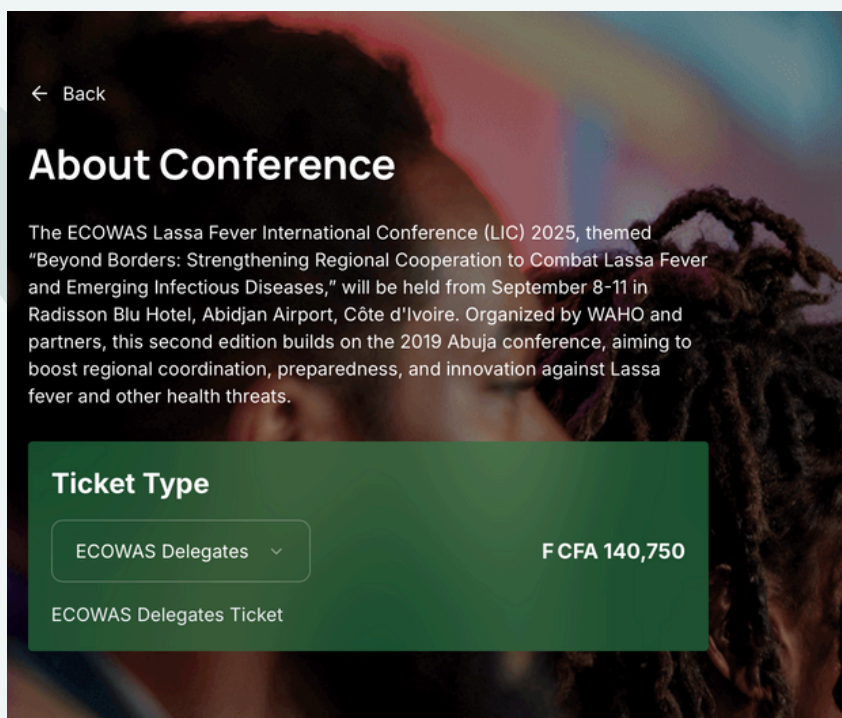
